#### SCCF accepts:

#### IRA Distributions:

For those 70 ½ or older, it is simple to make a qualified charitable distribution from their IRA directly to SCCF, **without declaring the distribution as income**. You can fund Field of Interest, Designated, Scholarships, and Undesignated funds as well as support operations at SCCF. *\*This provision does NOT allow transfers to Donor Advised Funds.*

#### Gifts of Grain:

For many cash basis farmers, significant tax savings can be achieved by donating crops grown in a previous tax year directly to a community foundation to support funds, grants, or scholarships.
