#### 2024 SCCF GRANT CYCLE UPDATE

South Central Community Foundation is excited to be celebrating our 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary in September!

With such a big anniversary, the SCCF Board and staff took an annual review of the grant cycle and we are excited to announce a big change for the 2024 Cycle (for a one-year term).

Exploring data received from our Community Listening Tours in the summer of 2022, SCCF has elected to offer one large \$15,000 grant as well as five \$1,000 grants to each of



the counties in our service area. \*All other grant opportunities such as Teacher's \$250 and specific county opportunities remain unchanged.

With the intent to impact a few of the areas identified by each of our communities, we hope this one-time grant cycle will offer nonprofits the opportunity to think bigger for their SCCF grant application.
